## **Transport Workers Union Dues Obligation**

Dear Brother's & Sisters

Article 25 of the collective bargaining agreement between the Transport Workers Union of America AFL-CIO and American Eagle Airlines and Executive Airlines (now Envoy) dated January 1, 2013, establishes that as a condition of employment, the requirement that all members sign a Dues Check-Off Card authorizing the deduction of the required union dues.

Article 25 further states that if a member becomes delinquent in the payment of his/her union dues for more than 60 days, the union will follow the procedures set forth in Article 25 (E) 1 & 2.

In addition to the contract requiring all members to remain current in the payment of union dues, the Constitution of the Transport Workers Union requires that the Local Union enforced the provisions of Article 25.

For some time, we have not enforced Article 25 of the contract and have been in violation of the Constitution which the Local Union is required to follow.

Going forward, effective January 1, 2017, Local 570 will enforce the provisions of Article 25.

In doing so, we have adopted a policy that we will not seek payment of any dues missed until a member becomes at least fifty dollars (\$50.00) in arrears.

At that time we will follow the procedures established in Article 25.
